Invasive, Non-native Species Removal & Planting for Wildlife**

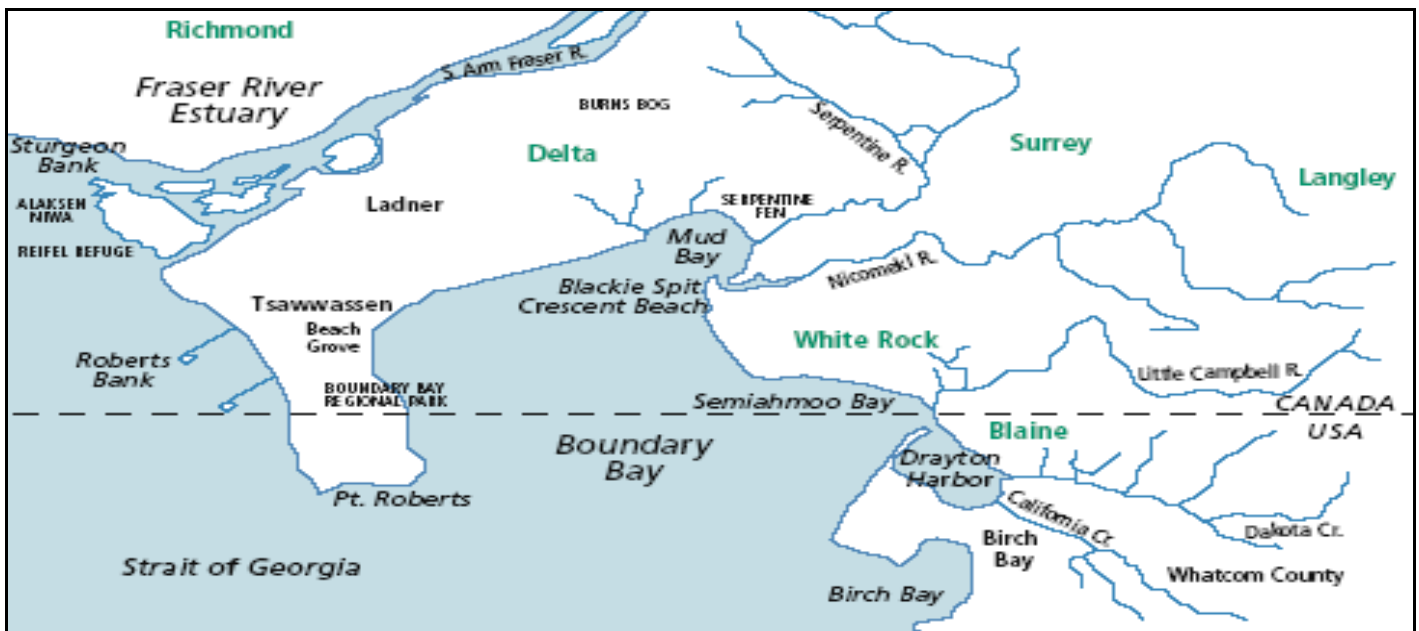
## *Current Projects*
